

How can you manage an indomethacin-responsive headache in someone who cannot take indomethacin?

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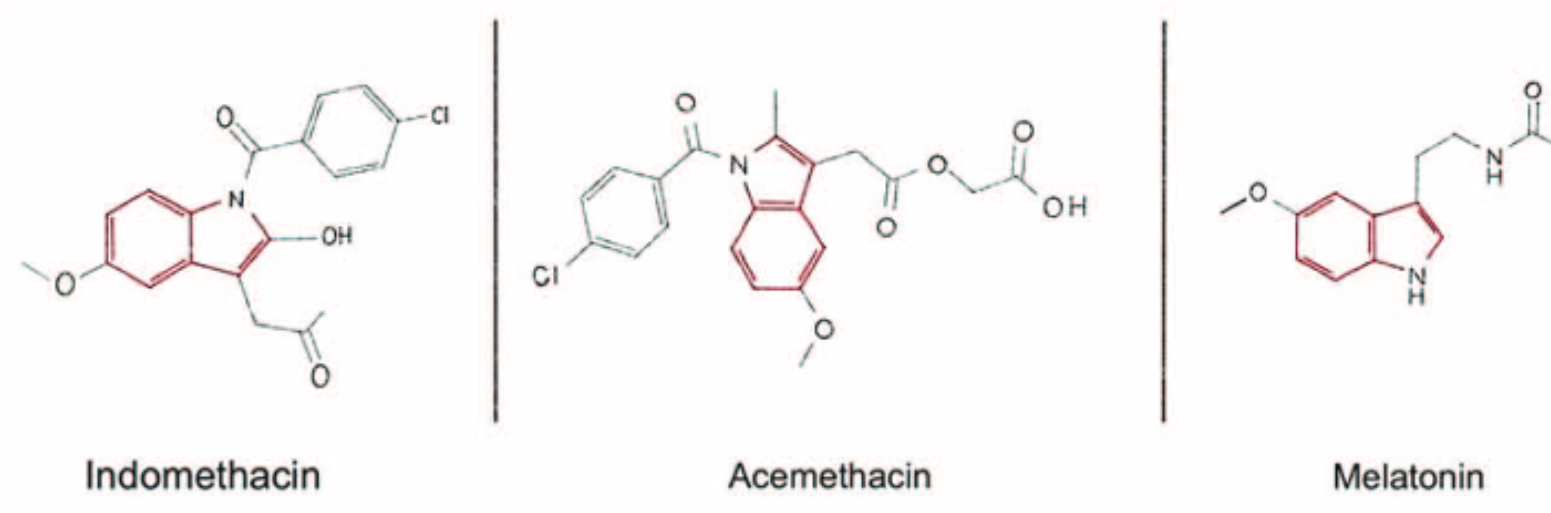
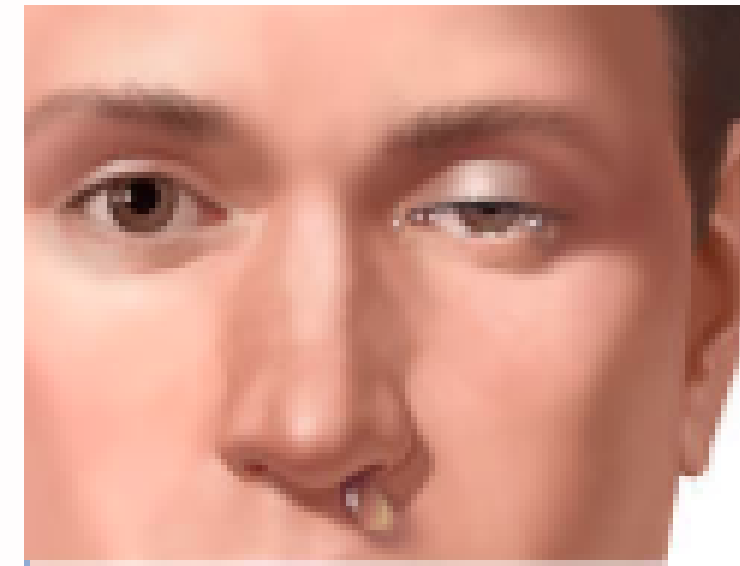
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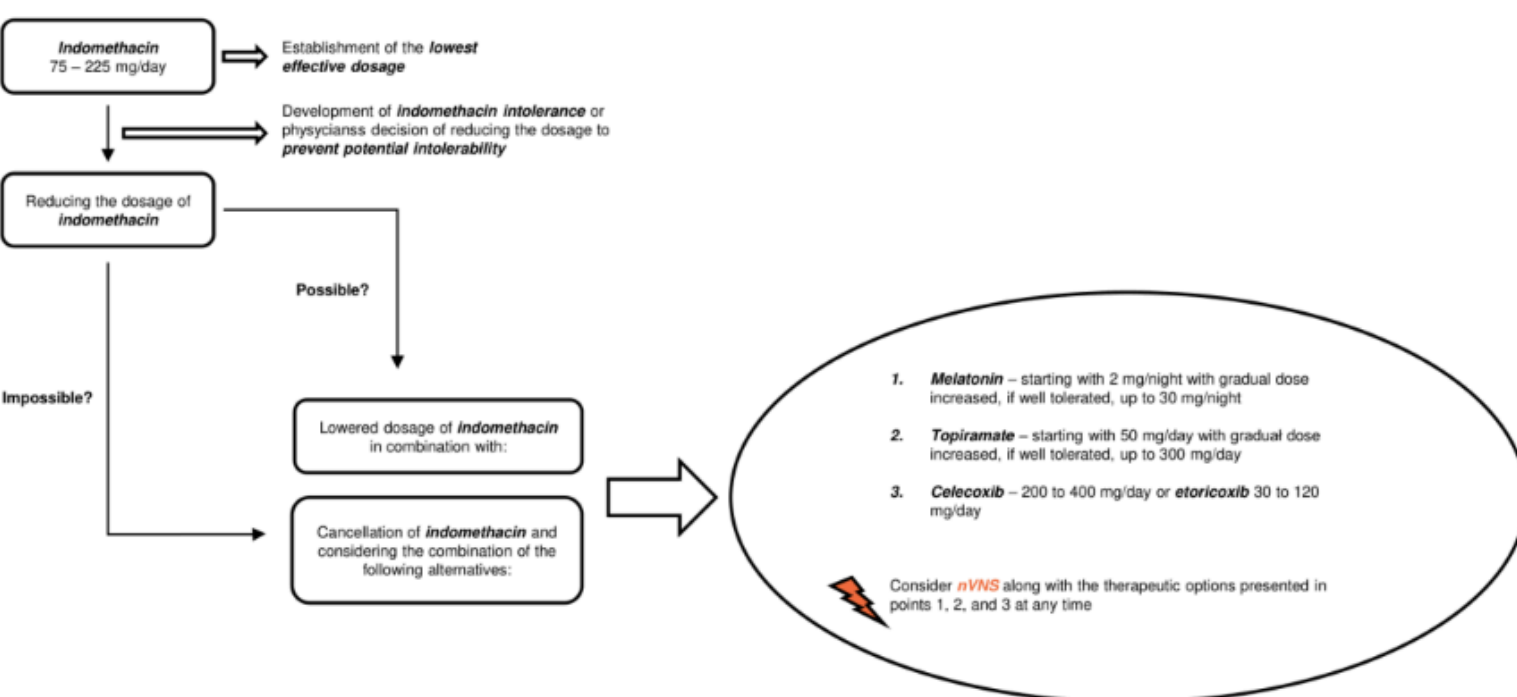
- **Paroxysmal hemicrania** and **hemicrania continua** are rare primary headache disorders which are distinguished by an absolute response to **indomethacin**.

- Currently, there are **no guidelines** regarding the alternative treatment options for **indomethacin**.

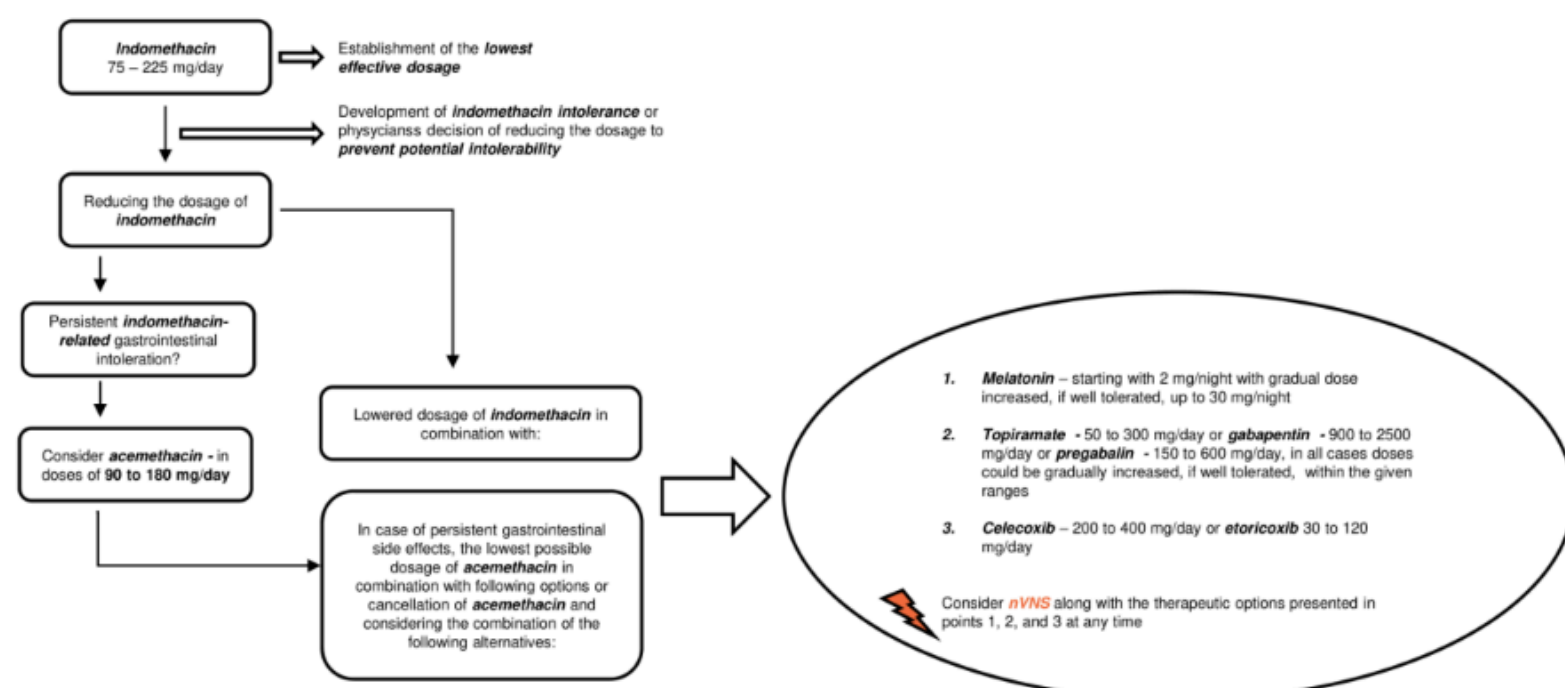
- Despite **indomethacin's** efficacy, it has been demonstrated that a substantial number of individuals suffer from its intolerability, mostly related to gastrointestinal, cardiovascular, and neuropsychiatric adverse events.
